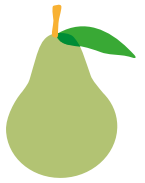


the DIY scent game



To create your homemade scent game, you will need:

- 6 small empty cups, you can use yogurt cups for instance
- Food for your scents: mint, orange, pear, lemon, sesame seeds, orange blossom, whatever you find in your kitchen!
- Colour cardstock
- Pictures of the scents, you can download the printable board sent in the email or to have your children draw them
- Cotton
- A sewing needle
- Glue



Step by step set up

On the colour cardstock, draw the outlines of the top of the cups, cut them out and pierce with the sewing needle. In each cup, place a little piece of cotton and the food of your choice. Under each cup, write the corresponding food. Stick the perforated lids on top of each cup with glue. Print and cut the game board and player cards from the printable page below.

How to play

Place the cups on the table in front of the players.

Each player takes a scent card. In turn each player picks a cup, smells it and tries to recognize the smell.

If the player recognizes it and has it on their board, they put down the corresponding scent card.

If the player doesn't recognize the scent or does not have it on their board, they put the cup back down and the game moves on to the next player's turn.

As you play, ask the children what these smells remind them of: holidays, a memory, a dish they have tried before or somebody's favorite food!

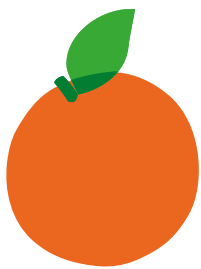
Printable board and cards

Print page 3 and cut it out following the dotted lines.

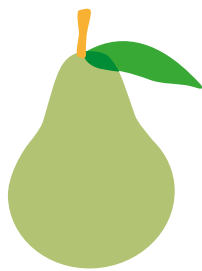


← The top part will be the game board to help your child recognize the scents.

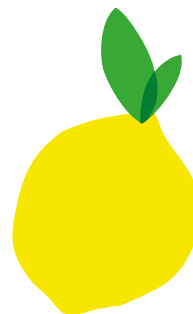
← The bottom part contains the player cards.

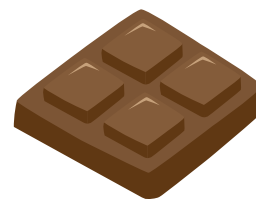

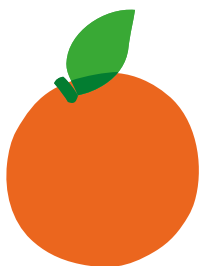

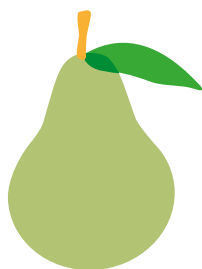

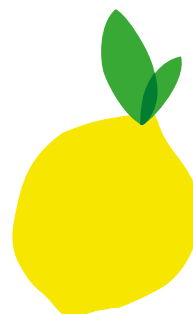
